**12 Revelations for Supernatural Living, Pt. 2**

So, we have been studying about 12 revelations for supernatural living. Revelation is an understanding of a spiritual principle from God's perspective (Mat 16:13-18).

**REVIEW**

*In our last lesson we talked about revelation on prosperity in Salvation. We learned that ....*

- *Prosperity means to do well or be successful in all areas of our lives. It includes our spiritual well-being, our health, our finances, every area of our lives.*
- *God wants you to prosper or be successful in every area of our lives.*
- *Prosperity is not an addition to salvation, but it is covered in salvation - John 10:10; Romans 8:32*

**Today's Focus:**

**Revelation on Prosperity in Salvation, Pt.2**

If God wants us to be prosperous, why are so many believers not prosperous?

It could be because of not being hardworking and diligent. It could be we are not exercising enough faith. It could be we don't have good ideas and so on. But after laboring in prayer and asking God this question, I have come to understand through many crying and tears that it is primarily because of a **misunderstanding of what Kingdom Prosperity is all about.**

**You cannot appropriate something you do not understand.**

To fully understand prosperity, you must look at the subject from a Kingdom Perspective and not from a Republic Perspective.

- ◆ Every Christian who is truly born again belong to the kingdom of God  
– **Colossians 1:13**

The kingdom of God is a country and as a result we must look at how the government looks at the wellbeing of its citizens.

### **Kingdom Prosperity Lessons from Matthew 6:25-34**

1. Basic needs should not become our motivation for living – Vs. 25
2. Self-worth is more important than basic needs – Vs. 26-27
3. My confidence in God to sustain His creation should cause me to make a relationship with him a priority – Vs. 28-30
4. My Prosperity is tied to my pursuit of the Kingdom of God and the Righteousness of God – Vs. 31-33
5. My Prosperity is the responsibility of the King – Vs. 34; Matthew 6:11; Exodus 16:4
6. Instead of worrying, I must focus on living one day at a time – Vs. 34; Deuteronomy 33:25.
