REVIEW

*"But seek **first** the kingdom of God and his righteousness, and all these things will be provided for you." (Mat 6:33, CSB)*

- The fundamental key to prosperity or success in any field of endeavor is learning to establish priorities and then living by them – Matt. 6:33
- *Priorities help us avoid distractions, focus on the most important things, and get the most value out of our time every day.*
- *Knowing our priorities will help us evaluate the voices pulling at us and identify which voice is most important.*
- *Knowing our priorities will help us distinguish right from good.*
- *Knowing the right priority helps us to pursue life with confidence.*

Today's Focus:

Revelation on Prosperity in Salvation, Pt.5

(What does it mean to SEEK God's Kingdom?)

*"But **seek** first the kingdom of God and his righteousness, and all these things will be provided for you." (Mat 6:33, CSB)*

What does it mean to seek?

- 1) Seek means to **search** - diligent, unceasing search until the object of the search is found – Jeremiah 29:13

Jer 29:13 (CSB) You will seek me and find me when you search for me with all your heart.

- 2) Seek means to **pursue** - chasing after a person or thing with the intent to catch – Luke 15:4

Luke 15:4 (CSB) “What man among you, who has a hundred sheep and loses one of them, does not leave the ninety-nine in the open field and go after the lost one until he finds it?”

- 3) Seek means to **study** – a detailed investigation and analysis of a subject or situation - Psalm 1:2; 2 Timothy 2:15

Psa 1:2 (AMPC) But his delight and desire are in the law of the Lord, and on His law (the precepts, the instructions, the teachings of God) he habitually meditates (ponders and studies) by day and by night.

2Ti 2:15 (NIV) Do your best to present yourself to God as one approved, a worker who does not need to be ashamed and who correctly handles the word of truth.

- 4) Seek means to **explore** – to become familiar with something by testing, experimenting, or traveling through it like a land.

We must explore the Kingdom’s power, its laws, its government, its culture, its society, its commands, its economy, its taxation—everything.

- 5) Seek means to **understand** – perceive the intended meaning
We can pursue something and never understand it. The search is complete when we understand it.

- 6) Seekers possess a **strong desire** for the search object, and they **think about** the object all day long.
