- 1. God has given all His followers unique gifts and abilities that He wants us to use to serve Him and others. What are one or two gifts or abilities you think you have? Jot it down.
- 2. Read the following lists of spiritual gifts. Write down the guidelines and insights you see regarding using your gifts and abilities to benefit the kingdom of God.

1 Corinthians 12:8-11 New Century Version (NCV)

8 The Spirit gives one person the ability to speak with <u>wisdom</u>, and the same Spirit gives another the ability to speak with <u>knowledge</u>. 9 The same Spirit gives <u>faith</u> to one person. And, to another, that one Spirit gives <u>gifts of healing</u>. 10 The Spirit gives to another person the <u>power to do miracles</u>, to another the ability to <u>prophesy</u>. And he gives to another the ability to know the <u>difference between good and evil spirits</u>. The Spirit gives one person the ability to <u>speak in different kinds of languages</u> and to another the ability to <u>interpret those languages</u>. 11 One Spirit, the same Spirit, does all these things, and the Spirit decides what to give each person.

Romans 12:6-8 New Century Version (NCV)

6 We all have different gifts, each of which came because of the grace God gave us. The person who has the gift of prophecy should use that gift in agreement with the faith. 7 Anyone who has the gift of serving should serve. Anyone who has the gift of teaching should teach. 8 Whoever has the gift of encouraging others should encourage. Whoever has the gift of giving to others should give freely. Anyone who has the gift of being a leader should try hard when he leads. Whoever has the gift of showing mercy to others should do so with joy.

1 Peter 4:10-11 New Century Version (NCV)

10 Each of you has received a gift to use to serve others. Be good servants of God's various gifts of grace. 11 Anyone who <u>speaks</u> should speak words from God. Anyone who <u>serves</u> should serve with the strength God gives so that in everything God will be praised through Jesus Christ. Power and glory belong to him forever and ever. Amen.

1 Corinthians 12:28 New Century Version (NCV)

28 In the church God has given a place first to <u>apostles</u>, second to <u>prophets</u>, and third to <u>teachers</u>. Then God has given a place to those who do <u>miracles</u>, those who have <u>gifts of healing</u>, those who can <u>help others</u>, those who are able to <u>govern</u>, and those who can <u>speak in different languages</u>.

Exodus 31:1-6 New Century Version (NCV)

1 Then the Lord said to Moses, 2 "See, I have chosen Bezalel son of Uri from the tribe of Judah. (Uri was the son of Hur.) 3 I have filled Bezalel with the Spirit of God and have given him the skill, ability, and knowledge to do all kinds of work. 4 He is able to design pieces to be made from gold, silver, and bronze, 5 to cut jewels and put them in metal, to carve wood, and to do all kinds of work. 6 I have also chosen Oholiab son of Ahisamach from the tribe of Dan to work with Bezalel. I have given skills to all the craftsmen, and they will be able to make all these things I have commanded you:

- 4. What stands out to you the most from these four scripture passages?
