Reasons Why Every Believer Must Discover, Develop, and Exercise their Spiritual Gift

- 1. So that you can join God in His pursuit to claim the world for Himself. (John 5:17, 1 Timothy 2:3-4)
- 2. You would be a useful tool in the hands of God (2 Timothy 2:20)
- 3. Just a reminder...You would account for it on the day of judgement (2 Corinth. 5:10, Romans 14:12)
- 4. To minister and meet the need of others. (1 Peter 4:10-11)

How do you discover your Gift.

- 1. Spent time with the gift giver.
- 2. Talk to your Spiritual leader.
- 3. Examine and evaluate yourself: Study all the gifts.
- 4. Experiment don't worry about failing.
