FOCUS – Saul's Story: Part 2, Acts 9:23-31

After his encounter with the Lord Jesus, Saul began to bring others to faith in Christ. Previously helped by Ananias, Saul is now being helped by Barnabas. Focusing our study on Barnabas, the book of Acts reveals 5 characteristics Barnabas showed that helped him encourage and build others up in the early church.

- Barnabas showed **Generosity** -Acts 4:36-37
- Barnabas showed **forgiveness** Acts 9:26-28
- Barnabas **encouraged** people Acts 11:19-30
- Barnabas showed **humility** Acts 13:1-52
- Barnabas showed <u>mercy</u> Acts 15:36-40
