Today's Focus: Outpourings, Pt. 2

Introduction

Last week we talked about the outpouring of the Holy Spirit. And we said that outpourings are "the answer to your situation."

Review

An outpouring in the context of this lesson is a divine move of God where He pours out without limits, His Spirit or Blessings on the believer, that causes the lives of those who receive it to never be the same.

Based on the scriptures, God Promises an Outpouring of The Holy Spirit and Blessings - Joel 2:28, Malachi 3:10-12

When we receive the outpouring of the Holy Spirit, it manifests in power, people (souls), praise (Isaiah 61:1-3), protection, and peace.

Many believers in Christ abort the manifestation of the outpouring because they think that all manifestations are instantaneous.

Not all spiritual manifestations are instantaneous.

- a) **Instantaneous** Manifestation (immediately) Matthew 8:3
- b) Incremental Manifestation (while they were going) Luke 17:14; John 9; Mark 4:26-28
- c) <u>Illumination</u> Manifestation (one word spoken and everything changes) –1 Samuel 1:12-20; Luke 1:36; Matt. 8:8

Since spiritual manifestations can be instantaneous, incremental, or illumination we have to respect the spiritual process that brings a manifestation into reality.

Many believers are sincere in their expectations but don't know how to receive them.

How to Receive a Promise?

In Romans 4:16-24, we see

- a. the Existence of Negative Facts vs. 19
 Abraham faced the facts. You must face the facts, don't deny it.
- b. the Establishment of New Facts vs. 20 Strengthened in faith by giving glory to God
- c. the Efforts to reach the level of "full persuasion vs. 21

How to receive a Promise?

- 1. Face the Negative Facts but attack them with faith
- 2. Establish New Facts by renewing your mind
- 3. Discipline yourself to walk in faith until you are <u>fully</u> <u>persuaded</u> that the negative facts can change.
 - Discipline is enforced obedience
 - Discipline is a matter of
 - Consecration
 - Information
 - Saturation
 - Confession
 - Deliberation
 - o Determination
 - Expectation
