Review

So we have been talking about the human heart, not the physical organ but the real you, and how our hearts are what both God and Satan are after. In our last few lessons, we have been doing a **heart check**. In Matthew 13:1-8 Jesus uses four conditions of the soil to illustrate 4 conditions of the human heart. These four conditions of the human heart are a **wayside** heart, stony places heart, among thorns heart, and good soil heart. So far, we have covered the wayside heart, the stony places heart, among thorns heart condition and this week we would look at the "good soil heart condition.

Today's Focus: "Good Soil" Heart Condition

We want to look at how *the deceitfulness of riches* grows alongside God's word in our hearts and choke the word.

Matthew 13:8, 23 (King James Version)

8 But other fell into good ground, and brought forth fruit, some an hundredfold, some sixtyfold, some thirtyfold. 23 But he that received seed into the good ground is he that heareth the word, and understandeth it; which also beareth fruit, and bringeth forth, some an hundredfold, some sixty, some thirty.
