FINANCIAL STEWARDSHIP REPORT

As of May 31, 2025, the current year net loss is \$12,698. Church income is 17.65% below budget.

Expenses are under budget and the primary reason why expenses are less than budget is because certain expenses do not occur evenly throughout the year, but the budget assumes they do (e.g. property insurance).


