Fifty years of Celebrating Excellence!

On behalf of the Lower Great Lakes Chapter of the National Academy of Television Arts & Sciences, I welcome you to the 50th Anniversary Gala of the Lower Great Lakes Regional Emmy® Awards, a Celebration of Television Excellence.

January 19, 1969, The Cleveland Chapter of the National Academy of Television Arts & Sciences charter was signed. The Chapter served the Toledo, Cleveland, Akron/Canton, Youngstown and Erie markets. The first Emmy Awards Gala was held on Thursday, June 4, 1969 only nine categories were honored. Fifty years later we are celebrating excellence in television across many platforms with over 100 categories, and the chapter has grown from a couple hundred television professionals in Cleveland to nearly a thousand members. "Television" itself has gone through big changes, in 1969 most TVs in America were still black and white. Programming is now delivered to a variety of devices, both stationary and portable allowing people to stay connected with their families and communities wherever they may be.

As we have done 49 times before, we come together to celebrate excellence throughout the region and across all media platforms. We honor our Silver Circle Inductees for their years of dedication and service. We celebrate with our college and high school production award winners, and we recognize potential future award winners with scholarships, to help them with their educational pursuits. We will also be honoring two television stations that share our anniversary, WTIU in Bloomington, Indiana and WUAB in Cleveland, Ohio, both celebrating 50 years.

Tonight, as we celebrate our 50th Anniversary Emmy Awards Gala. We also celebrate you, the hard working television and media professionals that are being honored tonight.

The first Cleveland Emmy Awards Gala in June 1969, started a tradition of honoring excellence. The Lower Great Lakes Chapter has been celebrating Excellence for the last 50 years. Thank you to all our members and your continued pursuit of Excellence for the next 50 years.

SILVER CIRCLE INDUCTEE JIM STUNEK



Jim Stunek started his broadcast career as an intern at WIXY Radio in 1969 at the age of 15, where he worked closely with Larry “The Duker” Morrow. In 1973 Jim moved over to WWWE radio where he became Music & Creative Services Director along with being Larry Morrow’s personal producer for his morning radio show. He’s also a talented arranger, composer, producer and studio musician. Utilizing that expertise, Jim collaborated with Larry to write not only the jingle for the Cavaliers, but numerous commercials including the American Commodore Tuxedo’s “I am a Tuxedo” spot that was voted the #1 commercial in America.

In 1982, Jim left radio to test his skills in television production, and he was hired as an audio engineer for UAB Productions – the production company affiliated with WUAB TV. Jim lent his

audio expertise to numerous local and regional commercial productions and, 1982 quickly advanced to commercial director in 1985. As director at UAB Productions, he worked closely with ad agencies, producers and talent, along with his crew to produce commercials and infomercials ranging from simple edits to extensive productions encompassing days of shooting and editing. Jim’s clients were everything from local car dealers to national banking institutions. UAB Productions put out quality products and Jim Stunek had a part in numerous commercials. The awards in his office include Telly Awards from productions with Saint Vincent’s, Easter Seals, Mr. Coffee, MTD/Yard Man and the Ohio Lottery, along with an Emmy for “Fanfare for Cleveland”, our city’s Bicentennial Celebration broadcast.

In 1990 Jim was promoted to Production Manager at UAB Productions and WUAB TV, overseeing all aspects of their promotional and commercial production, including UAB Productions immense direct response cliental. When Malrite - owner of WOIO TV - purchased WUAB in 1994 and formed Cleveland’s first duopoly, Jim was one of the few former employees from the WUAB side to keep his position and title – adding another TV station to his production team. During another restructuring at Raycom Media, Jim’s title and responsibilities moved into another direction – when he became Director of Operations and Engineering in 2010 - overseeing more employees on the technical side. In recent years he oversaw the automation of WOIO’s news production, a complete upgrade of the station’s physical plant, and played a key role in the launch of WOIO’s innovative OTT studio, which allows on-air talent to control the digital broadcast themselves. In 2018, Jim was the technical liaison for the long overdue return to live broadcast of the Cleveland Marathon.

Jim is a well-respected person in the broadcasting field – when his name is mentioned you only hear praise to follow. He can talk engineering to the engineers, production to the production team, news to the newsroom and he can even sweet talk his bosses. He’s a brilliant individual that can always fix any problem you may have, while still maintaining his dry sense of humor. Jim retired as Director Of Technology from WOIO/WUAB in January of 2019 after 37 years at the station.





SILVER CIRCLE INDUCTEE RON REGAN



Emmy Award winning investigative reporter Ron Regan's 44-year career has spanned some of Cleveland and the nation's most significant news events.

Ron joined WEWS-TV in 1999 and over the last two decades, his reporting includes coverage of the Cuyahoga County corruption scandal, serial killer Antony Sowell, a U.S. Justice Department review of Cleveland Police and the release of three young Cleveland woman held hostage for ten years.

With more than four decades of experience, Ron's work has been honored with one of the nation's most distinguished recognitions—The George Foster Peabody Award for Excellence after uncovering the

link between radiation exposure and cancer among veterans.

Ron has received multiple awards as Best Investigative Reporter, along with 24 Regional Emmy's, five Edward R. Murrow Regional Awards as well as being honored with a National Headliner Award. His award-winning investigations have freed an innocent man from prison, changed state laws making it easier to donate pharmaceuticals to those in need and required public disclosure of inspection reports of service providers for the disabled.

Ron's investigations have also exposed corruption and fraud which directly resulted in prison sentences for a cosmetologist performing illegal medical procedures, the arrest and conviction of the mastermind behind one of the largest housing fraud scams in Ohio history, as well as a federal probe into a physician ultimately convicted of selling illegal painkillers.

Just recently, his 3-year-investigation into the Cleveland Water Department prompted the NAACP Legal Defense Fund to issue a report finding the water department policies and procedures are both "discriminatory" and leading to a "devastating loss of home ownership."

Ron began his career in 1975 as a general assignment reporter for the Charleston, WV "Daily Mail" before joining WSAZ-TV in Huntington, WV where he rose to anchor the region's top rated 11 p.m. newscast in 1976. His career included WAVE-TV in Louisville, KY. and KRON-TV in San Francisco where he served as weekend anchor before leaving for KPRC-TV in Houston in 1984. While at KPRC, Ron's reporting included an interview with convicted assassin James Earl Ray; the 1993 Branch Davidian Siege at Waco; reporting from Germany on the 1985 release of American hostages onboard TWA Flight 847 from Cairo to Beirut that included a Houston native; as well as the "murder for hire plot" detailing a suburban mom intent on hiring a hit man to murder her daughter's cheerleader rival that ultimately became an HBO Emmy-winning movie based on his investigation. For his body of work, Ron was recognized by Penn State University's Donald P. Bellisario College of Communication with its 2018 Outstanding Alumni Award for "excellence in the field of communications for contributions to the profession and exemplary reputation among colleagues".

Ron credits the love, support, guidance and advice from his wife Flo, a 37-year marriage, and our son "J.P." who now, with our daughter-in-law Megan, have given us the great gift of our granddaughter "Brianna Maria".





SILVER CIRCLE INDUCTEE LLOYD WRIGHT



Lloyd Wright has more than four decades of service in public media. In his current role as President and CEO of WFYI Public Media in Indianapolis, he oversees Indiana's flagship PBS and NPR member stations, which includes WFYI Productions — a full service media production facility; WFYI's Community Engagement and Learning Services; Indiana Reading and Information services (IRIS) — a free service for Indiana's print impaired; as well as the WFYI Foundation.

The longest-serving station manager in Indianapolis, Wright joined WFYI in 1988 as Director of Program Production. The following year, Lloyd was appointed WFYI's President and Chief Executive Officer. In addition to his service at WFYI, Lloyd served for six years as Broadcast Operations Manager at WTTW (Chicago Public Television), was Producer/Director/Writer for the Indiana University News Bureau and Director of Instructional Broadcasting for the Indiana Department of Education.

Under Lloyd's leadership, WFYI's annual operating budget has grown from \$2.5 million in 1988, to more than \$11.8 million today. Additionally, WFYI relocated in 2008 to a state-of-the-art facility along "Broadcast Row" in downtown Indianapolis – now also home to more than a dozen tenant-partners; established an innovative partnership with The Economic Club of Indiana; and collaborated with countless community partners in areas of health, education, arts and culture, news and public affairs, as well as Indiana history. WFYI Public Media has also flourished as a multi-media content provider with its three distinct public television services, two HD public radio channels, interactive website and a growing array of social media assets.

In 2008, WFYI successfully completed a \$20 million capital campaign, and was awarded a \$900,000 Kresge Foundation Capital Grant. In recognition of its innovative fundraising practices and overall growth in membership and donor relations, WFYI has been honored with multiple PBS Development Awards, including the "Award of Excellence for Overall Membership."

Lloyd has served four three-year terms on the PBS Board of Directors, including the PBS Executive Committee, past chair of the board of National Datacast, Inc. (a PBS subsidiary), Chair of the Corporate Support Advisory Committee, Vice Chair of the Interconnection Committee, and member of the Station Services, and Nominating and Corporate Governance Committees. Wright is also a member of the American Public Television (APT) board of directors and currently serves as Chair Emeritus. Locally, Wright serves on the boards of the Greater Indianapolis Progress Committee, The Economic Club of Indiana, and The Confucius Institute at IUPUI. Lloyd also serves as a member of the Board of Trustees for Central Christian Church in downtown Indianapolis.

Wright is the former chair of the Joint Licensee Group, made up of all the joint radio and TV stations in public broadcasting; as well as Public Television Major Market Group (PTMMG), a consortium of 40 public television stations from the nation's largest broadcast markets. Under his leadership, PTMMG expanded its membership and implemented two pilot programs designed to foster collaborative efforts in the creation of cultural and public affairs programs by the organization's member stations. In recognition of his outstanding service, Lloyd was awarded the PTMMG's highest honor in 2012, the William Kobin Public Television Leadership Award.

Throughout his years of service, Wright has been recognized with multiple awards including Emmy Awards for Technical Achievement and four Station of Excellence Awards, as well as two Sagamore of the Wabash honors, the highest award given by the Governor to recognize distinguished service to the state of Indiana. Lloyd was also presented the 2017 Advancing American Democracy Award from the Benjamin Harrison Presidential Site. WFYI has also earned distinctions from the National Academy of Television Arts and Sciences, Society of Professional Journalists, the Public Radio News Directors Incorporated, Associated Press and the Indiana Broadcasters Association and more. In October of 2013, Lloyd received the distinguished honor of being inducted into the Indiana Broadcasters Association Pioneers Hall of Fame.

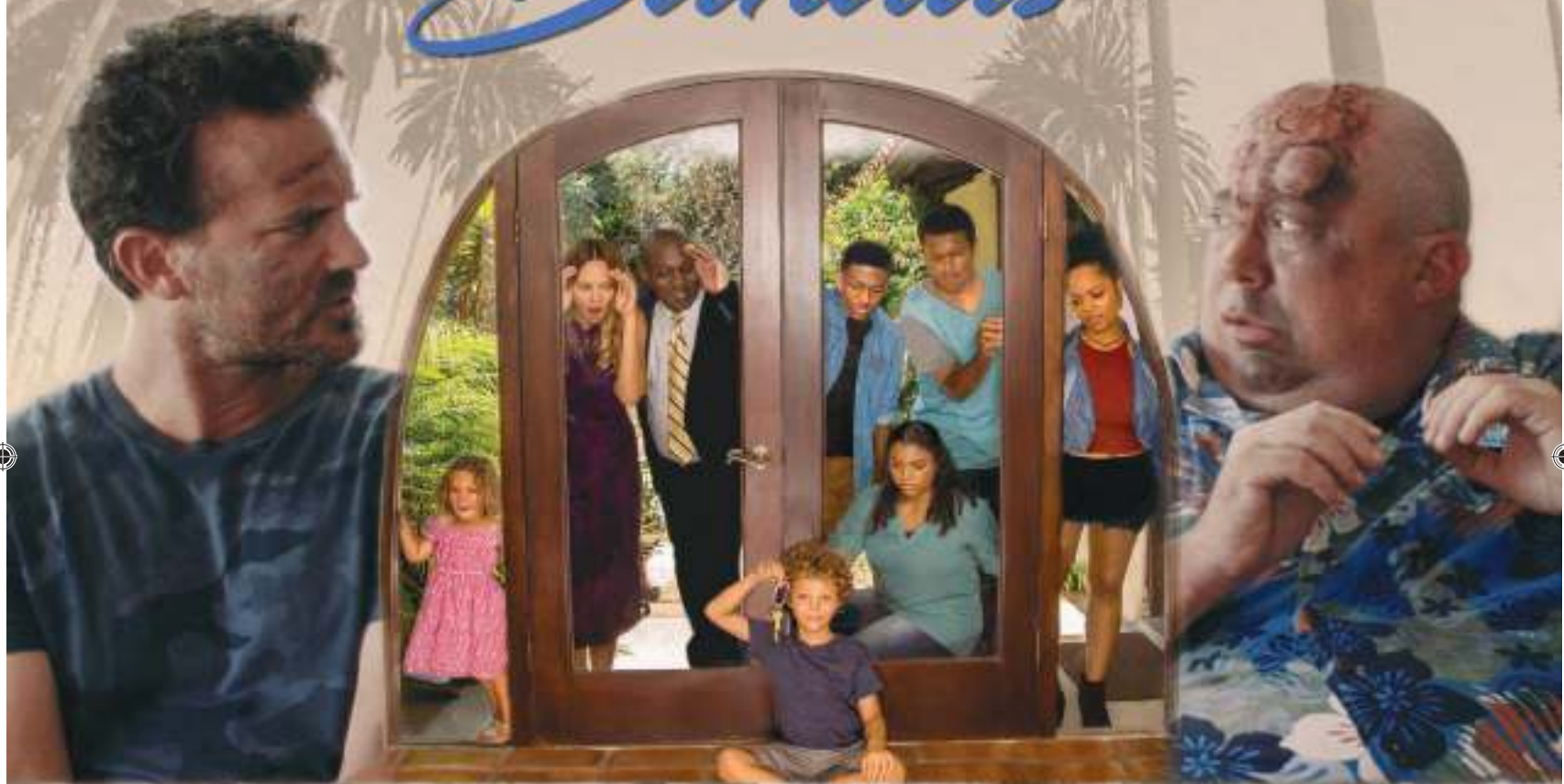

The 50th Annual Emmy® Awards Scenic Design

Kent State University School of Theatre and Dance's Design Studio: Scenery class designed the set for the 50th Annual Lower Great Lakes NATAS Awards. The concept for the set is to embrace the golden anniversary of the chapter and the elegance of the Emmy® statuette.

The class taught by Tamara L. Honesty, Assistant Professor of Scenic Design, is a mixture of four junior undergraduate BFA Scenic Design, Technology, & Production majors (Noah Blievernicht, Tiffanie Chau-Dang, Christine Harmel, and Alex Heffner) and three first-year MFA graduate students in Scenic Design & Technical Direction (Tetta Askeland, Alex Barnhart, and Steve Sawicki). The process began with the show's producers, John Stealey and Bob Hammer, along with Ted Van Hyning of NPi Audio Visual Solutions meeting with the students to present the concept for the awards and discuss the specifics of the Marriott Renaissance Ballroom. Stealey presented the organization's concept for the ceremony – an evening of elegance and excellence – and their request for an out of the box and innovative design that took the hotel ballroom's layout and the traffic flow of presenters, winners and the audience into account. Van Hyning provided technical drawings of the space and a list of stock items available for the design. The students divided into to three teams to develop designs.

Each team presented a scenic design proposal to Stealey, Van Hyning, and Hammer. Following the initial presentations, the designs were shared with the Lower Great Lakes NATAS board, which proposed revisions that allowed the students to combine the three distinct designs into one cohesive production design for the ceremony.

The students embraced the budgeting, planning, and acquisition of materials phase of the project by dividing up duties amongst themselves to complete the many tasks in a limited time frame. The scope of construction was quite ambitious to accomplish in the last few weeks of the semester. The teams created a large faceted 6-step grand staircase, a 40-ft valance of three swags, and large letters to spell EMMY for a photo op station. The students painting talents are exhibited on the grand staircase and pedestals for the letters.

The project was an excellent educational experience to expose the students to a real-world scenario of staging an awards show in a large downtown hotel property with limited time and resources available. The partnership with NPi Audio Visual Solutions to design the set from a pre-arranged equipment list of LCD and LED panels to create dynamic video surfaces is an invaluable opportunity since those resources aren't available to the students on a daily basis. It required them to research and consider how their graphic ideas would work in a video monitor ratio. Additionally, they had the opportunity to explore working with new products like paillette fabric and Rosco Premiere Clear sealer. The students worked together as one cohesive unit and within tight budgetary and time constraints to design/build a set that will be installed and dismantled all in the same day.
